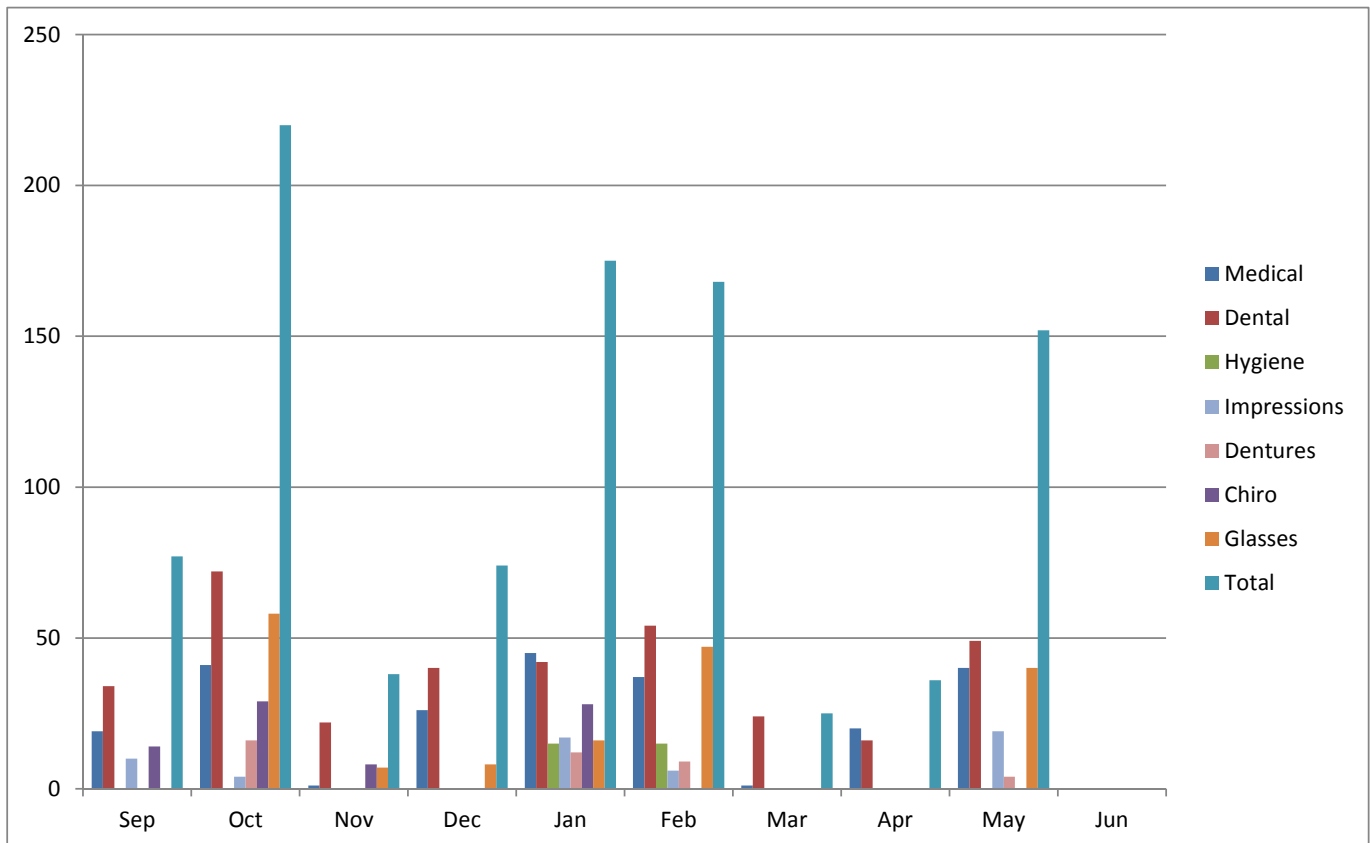

Friday, May 8, 2015

We had two airplanes depart Ryan Field at around 0700 Friday and a third around 0745 headed toward San Felipe where we cleared into Mexico. The weather was a bit unfriendly with some clouds and strong headwinds. The winds caused us to fly lower than usual and also produced a little choppiness during the flight.

Carl Foster and I arrived at Robertson's Ranch Airstrip around 1030. I checked the vans and took one filled with the providers necessary to get dental up and running to the clinic. Carl waited for Alexis Hernandez and drove the remaining providers to the clinic in the other van, arriving about 45 minutes after I did.

There were people waiting for us at the clinic and they had already started a sign-in sheet. I got the clinic open and we started to prepare for the patients. Christine coordinated the activities, and got dental up and running in about 20 minutes. Our only problem was two of the sinks, one in dental and the other in the medical room, neither would drain. However, this was not critical and we were able to provide all services without a problem.

When Alexis arrived he took over triage from Christine. Alexis has done a lot of triage at the clinic and it shows. Using his language skills he communicates well with the patients and coordinates the different procedures each patient will need. He really does much more than triage; he facilitates the dental activities.

Our only dentist for Friday was Jim Wright. He had been to the clinic in the past so was familiar with the set up. However, we also had Kevin Wang, a dental student, assisting him along with Bob Watson. Keeping dental running smoothly was, of course, Linda Algar.

Bob Smith set up shop in his dental lab and worked at producing dentures for the patients. This is an invaluable service for those in El Rosario, because many times Bob can take an impression, make the partial dentures and get them to the patient the same day.

Medical was provided by Lucia Esparza, a bilingual Nurse Practitioner. This was her first time to the clinic so she took a little time to get familiar with the layout and what was available in the pharmacy. She saw a total of 20 patients on Friday and needed little assistance from the rest of us. In fact, she offered her support in dental as well.

After organizing all the activities at the clinic, Christine started seeing patients who wanted eye glasses.

While all this was happening I took Kathy Salm, another first time provider, into town to visit several of the grocery stores. Kathy is a nutrition expert (as well as a pilot) and wanted to see what foods the population of El Rosario had access to. In the future, Kathy hopes to be able to do some nutrition education classes for the patients in hopes of helping them control diabetes and other diseases.

We closed up the clinic around 1630 and drove back to the hotel where we had our first real problem of the day. Apparently, the hotel thought we had canceled our trip so they canceled our reservations. After some clever negotiations and room sharing we got enough rooms for everyone with the promise that enough additional rooms would be available for our providers arriving Saturday.

It was late. Everyone was tired from the long day, so we decided to eat at the hotel. It was a good meal, as usual.

Saturday, May 9, 2015

This time of year Baja California Norte, the northern state on the Baja, is on Pacific Daylight Time, which is the same as Arizona time, but we call it Mountain Standard Time. I had made an announcement to this effect, but some were still confused.

We decided to meet at 0730 to drive to El Rosario and eat at Mama Espinoza's Restaurant. This gives us a little variety for our breakfasts and also gives the business to Mama's Restaurant. Add to this that the food is very good, making it a good choice.

We got the clinic open around 0930 with the same crew as on Friday. One difference was that Kathy picked up the eyeglass role from Christine and did a remarkable job, especially considering she doesn't speak Spanish and did not have the luxury of an interpreter. Even so, she was able to test and fit 31 patients with eyeglasses.

Around 1100 John Osborne arrived at Diamante Del Mar, the airport at El Rosario, with our second dentist Chris Douville. He also brought along a surprise mystery guest, Howard

Deevers. Howard is a pilot and has flown for us in the past. He was not scheduled to join us, but felt like spending the day at the clinic so jumped in John's airplane.

With Chris's help and John interpreting, dental was able to see more patients and ended up with a count of 33, just over double what had been seen on Friday.

Roli, Mama's daughter, surprised us with free Fish Tacos for lunch. It was a very much appreciated and delicious treat.

Christine was concerned about the storage space available at the clinic. So Carl went around measuring areas where we might be able to install shelves or cabinets. He also picked up the radio we installed at Mama's Restaurant to fix an over modulation problem.

We closed the clinic late, around 1745. This put us at the hotel around 1900 and we had our second surprise for the day. The additional rooms they had promised for us on Saturday had evaporated. So, with some novel reshuffling of people, and a lot of doubling up, we were able to provide a room for everyone.

Again we were very tired from the extraordinarily long day, so we once again decided to eat at the hotel since it was already 2000.

Sunday, May 10, 2015

Most met for breakfast at 0700 and by 0800 everyone was driving to the airport with the exception of those in John's plane. He wanted to delay his hotel departure until 0900. Everyone was airborne (except John) around 0900. The strong winds out of the west we experienced on Friday had changed and now were much lighter, but now from the east. So we had a small headwind on the way home.

It was a very smooth flight and we landed around 1130. John arrived about two hours later since he had landed in San Felipe for fuel on the way back. He also had an extended visit with Customs since their computer had apparently dropped his inbound notification.
