

Friday, Jun 12, 2015

All the Friday airplanes departed from Ryan Airfield around 0700. It was a smooth flight to San Felipe, where we cleared Mexican customs. From there it should have been a 30 minute flight to the Robertson's Ranch Airstrip in San Quintin. However, once I crested the mountains on the Baja I could see there was a substantial marine layer of solid clouds from the mountains to as far as I could see over the ocean. We didn't know how low the marine layer went, and were unable to see any breaks in the clouds. I decided to fly the instrument approach into Robertson's Ranch. We entered the clouds at about 2500 feet and with some excellent assistance from my co-pilot, Linda Algar, we broke out at around 900 feet precisely aligned with the runway three miles directly in front of us. The visibility below the clouds was excellent. We landed and waited for the other planes. Tim Burris flew the approach with the same result. However, Carl Foster is not instrument rated and therefore could not enter the clouds, so flying the approach was not an option for him. He flew above the clouds looking for a hole large enough to fly through, but never found one. He ended flying back to San Felipe to wait for the weather to break.

Flying the approach and then waiting to figure out what Carl would do, put us a little late into the Clinic in El Rosario. On the drive to the clinic we noticed the clouds remaining solid. When we came to Diamonte Del Mar, the airport in El Rosario, we found ourselves in the clouds with low visibility. It was clear this airport would not be usable for a while.

We found a number of people waiting for us at the clinic. With Carl and his passengers in San Felipe, we only had one dentist, Sophie Baird, to handle dental. She did a marvelous job, seeing 9 patients during the day.

Tim Burris and I kept a watch on the weather, and ultimately concluded that Carl Foster was not going to be able to get in. I called Carl and told him the situation and he and his passengers decided to get some rooms and spend the night in San Felipe. The question would be whether or not the weather would be good enough for Carl to get in on Saturday.

Hedging my bets, I called Randy Wells, the pilot of the Saturday airplane. He had two empty seats and after talking to him, he agreed to fill those seats with Sara Garcia, a dentist, and Tricia Conrad, a dental hygienist, from Carl's plane when he landed at San Felipe. Randy is instrument rated, and therefore would be able to fly the approach and almost certainly be able to land.

While Tim and I were checking out the weather, Iris Labra, the new clinic coordinator, was getting the feel of her role while at the clinic. Christine helped show her the ropes and both supplied excellent interpretation for the providers along with a first timer, Amanda Patterson.

Bruce Baird was a great help around the clinic in getting things fixed as well as proposing how we could make the water system better. He took some careful notes and we should be able to implement some of the improvements during the work clinic in August. This will give us a more reliable water system.

We closed the clinic around 4:30 PM and drove to the hotel. The eight of us decided to go to Los Jardines for dinner. It was a good choice since the restaurant was not busy and the food was excellent.

Saturday, Jun 13, 2015

Saturday morning's weather was the same as Friday's. There was a solid overcast with good visibility underneath. We decided to have breakfast at Mama's Restaurant in El Rosario so left the hotel around 8:00. We stopped by the airport and left one of the vans for Randy and Carl in case they all made it in. However, the Jeep would not start. It turned out to be a bad battery connection which we were able to fix temporarily. Tim and I drove the Jeep.

After evaluating the weather, we advised Carl that the weather had not improved and suggested that he and his two remaining passengers, Bob Smith and Bob's granddaughter, Baylee Smith, return to Tucson. That's what Carl did and arrived back in Tucson around noon.

Randy did fly the approach and was able to land. This gave us an additional two dentists and a hygienist for Saturday. Arriving at the clinic around 1100, Sara Garcia and her husband, Tim Cross, immediately got to work, relieving a lot of pressure from Sophie. Tricia Conrad started working dental hygiene. The courtyard was full with patients waiting for dental.

With 3 dentists and a hygienist we were able to see a large number of patients. Linda Algar kept the dental office running smoothly as usual

Sunday, Jun 14, 2015

Sunday turned out to be a good weather day. We had breakfast at the hotel and by the time we made it to the airport any clouds that were around had vanished. The flight home was smooth, although we were fighting some light headwinds; All arrived safely in Tucson.

The Jeep has developed a problem with the anti-theft system. We were unable to disarm the system and as a result the car would initially start and then immediately shut down. After working on it for over an hour and getting local help, we decided to leave it in El Rosario with a mechanic to get it fixed. We also arranged for the steering dampener that Tim had brought down, to be installed. This will eliminate the "wobble" we've experience on occasion.

Personal Note:

This was Christine's last clinic as clinic coordinator. She has moved over to membership and will continue to travel with us as an interpreter. I've been the pilot coordinator for almost 10 years. I've worked with many clinic coordinators, but Christine was the best. Her dedication and timeless effort always produced an efficient and effective clinic.
