

Time Zones and Daylight Saving Time:

Baja California will be observing Pacific Daylight Time on our next clinic, scheduled for April 14. That makes them the same time as Arizona. So 10:00 on your watch is 10:00 in El Rosario or San Quintin. Remember, most cell phones are set to automatically show the local time.

Pilots need to remember the San Felipe Airport ALWAYS opens at 0800 Arizona time. San Felipe adjust their hours to make this happen.

triage (with assistance as needed from John). <u>Maria Kenneally's</u> husband, <u>Brian</u> came along and just like Maria had on her first clinic, pitched right in.

DENTAL

Norman Don and Nick Meyer kept the dental patients moving through. Nick had some conversations with other Flying Samaritans about the clinic itself and how to manage the client flow.

Hygienists Tricia Conrad and Richelle Aquino kept things moving in our second room with cleanings. Looking very professional in their pink lab. coats. Stephanie Calles, dental assistant some how managed to assist both dentists and keep things moving.

Amazingly enough, by about 15.30 there were no dental patients waiting and no-one had waited over-long for care, though Bob Smith was still in his lab. working wonders on dentures.



MEDICAL



Medical was steady with Maria seeing 12 patients on Friday and sixteen on Saturday. Gratefully, nothing that we could not manage.

Kathleen, when not triaging, helped in pharmacy dispensing medications and keeping track of what need to be obtained or purchased. 57 Pharmaceuticals were dispensed to patients along with some dressings.

The new ear irrigation set has a spot in pharmacy in a labeled, and easy to see, clear plastic box.

An older lady presented at the medical clinic with a large statis ulcer. She has done a remarkable job of healing said ulcer using honey. We distributed dressing materials so she could continue with her own excellent care.

OPERATIONS

Chuck Schroll and Bill Hunt addressed some urgent vehicular maintenance, purchasing new tires and getting them installed.

Chuck also cleaned out all the door tracks on the vans and lubricated them. They are much easier to open and close now.
